The seeing is on many different levels both outer and inner. The foundation of the work is laid through the practice of twelve light and darkness exercises and their corresponding colour pictures.

All of the above, together with medical lectures and case studies, help each person to go on their own healing journey; a necessary prerequisite for being able to work effectively with others.

The students own practise at home involves daily painting, charcoal work, observation exercises, meditation, study and written assignments.
